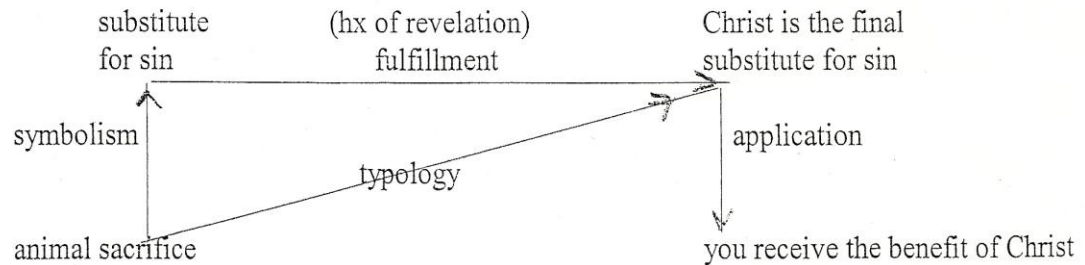


*principles for interpreting types:

Step 1: When God introduced the symbol (event, person, institution, etc.), what did it mean for the people then?

Step 2: Now begin to trace the symbol through redemptive history. What greater manifestation of truth does the symbol embody and anticipate?

Step 3: Now apply personally. How do we participate in the fulfillment of this truth?

Step 4: How does fulfillment illuminate earlier stages of redemptive history?

Step 5: Bring out the deepened understanding of earlier stages of redemptive history by noting what we may learn of God and his ways. Is there more significance to the earlier stage?

Step 6: Get the big-picture view of the symbol from creation to consummation.

Step 7: Reflect on the distinctiveness of each redemptive-historical epoch with respect to the truth embodied through the symbol.
